

## 2013 Results and Highlights.

### DIRECT SERVICE

- 101** in-risk youth served through community violence intervention, subsidized employment and re-entry support services
- 80** at-risk youth were connected to jobs
- 20** youth completed 2,000 hours of subsidized work and professional job training
- 7%** reduction in gang-related homicides as a result of intervention in Chicago's Humboldt Park and Hermosa neighborhoods

### TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

- 392** people trained on multidisciplinary topics related to domestic violence, sexual assault, teen dating violence, stalking, and children exposed to violence
- All (56)** federal states and territories improved responses to domestic violence, sexual assault, teen dating violence, and stalking as a result of training and technical assistance
- 37** communities nationwide improved responses to children exposed to violence as a result of training and technical assistance
- 23** street violence intervention specialists improved responses to intimate partner violence in Chicago as a result of training and technical assistance
- 19** community members and practitioners improved bystander intervention skills through *Your Life is My Life* training

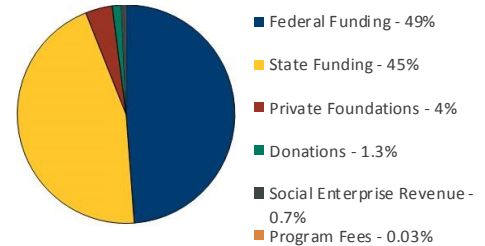

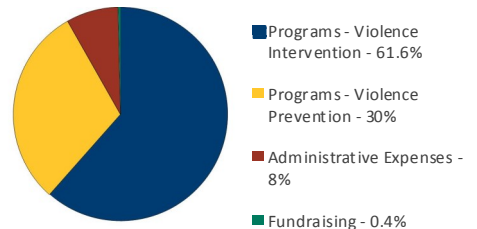
