About this product:

In an environmental context, "sustainability" generally

means finding a way to use resources in a manner that prevents their depletion. Applying the environmental definition to the nonprofit context applies a more holistic, trauma-informed lens to sustainability. If we consider nonprofit sustainability in this manner, we have to consider how we define our resources, and what it means to prevent their depletion as critical to perpetuating our ability to fulfill our missions. Conceptualizing sustainability as holistic means that our inventory of resources include not only funding, but also talent, time, reputation, community, culture, traditions, relationships, and infrastructure.

Progress Reporting

Message from VAWA Measuring Effectiveness Initiative (MEI)/OVW.

OVW has extended the submission deadline for all performance reports that were due on January 30, 2021. The new deadline for submitting your report in the Just Grants system is *February 28, 2021*. This extension pertains to performance reports for the July-December 2020 period. The extension should be reflected in Just Grants soon.
